Les enjoyed a very successful second career as a church and synagogue organist in Los Angeles, playing and conducting choirs until he decided to leave all that to play piano in a professional Dixieland band. He has since worked with several of the country's most popular Dixieland bands--despite having never had a piano lesson. Les has also continued his trumpet playing and has taught himself many other wind and percussion instruments. He performs professionally on many of these.
