Dear Members and Friends,

By the time you read this, the Poorman's Organ Convention in Bakersfield will be but a memory. We ran an article in the last Organ Log about the convention. I was not able to attend this year but have attended in past years and wanted to share my enjoyment of these past conventions.

The Poorman's Organ Convention takes place at the Granada Theatre in the old section of Bakersfield. The convention is the brainchild of Jim Spohn, who owns the Granada Theatre. He wanted to create an inexpensive venue where theatre organ fans could come to listen and play if he or she wished.

The Granada is a small neighborhood theatre built in the late 1920's. The theatre did not have an organ but had a place for a piano. Provision was made for a sound system, as they knew that "talkies" were on their way. Jim removed some of the seats and built chambers on each side of the theatre

The organ is a hybrid containing 24 ranks of Wurlitzer, Morton and other makes of pipe work. The console is an early Robert Morton 3 manual which has a fourth manual added. In addition to the interesting and varied music, many technical discussions occur over the weekend. Jim Spohn and his wife Lucy are gracious hosts and attendees enjoy their hospatility.

AN ELECTRONIC ORGAN LOG?

LATOS has three fixed costs: accounting, casualty and liability insurance, and the Organ Log. These three expenses alone exceed our income from annual dues.

As a not-for-profit organization, LATOS does not pay taxes, but we are required by law to have our books audited by a registered CPA who prepares an annual report to the IRS and State of California. Casualty insurance covers damage to the organs, while liability covers injury by those attending our events. The venues that we use require us to carry liability before we can set foot on their property.

Our greatest single fixed expense is the Organ Log. It now costs us the bulk of your annual dues to print and mail the Log.

We are now preparing the Organ Log

electronically, which means it could be transmitted directly to you in PDF form via email, reducing the cost of printing and postage. Aside from saving LATOS money, you would receive your Log sooner, and those who file your Logs for future reference could do so by downloading to a CD and store years of Logs on one small CD.

ON LOCATION: SILENT FILMS IN ORANGE COUNTY

Between 1910 and 1930, Orange County might well have been called "Hollywood's back lot." Hundreds of films, ranging from comic shorts and newsreels to full-length silent movies were made during this period. "The Two Brothers," filmed in 1910 at Mission San Juan Capistrano under the direction of legend D.W. Griffith, was the first motion picture filmed in Orange County. Movie greats Harold Lloyd, Buster Keaton and native Roscoe "Fatty" Arbuckle all appeared in movies here, as well as Gilbert Roland, Mary Pickford, Douglas Fairbanks, Lon Chaney and Rudolph Valentino. This exhibit includes photographs, artifacts, props, movie posters, and a replica costume from Theda Bara's "Cleopatra," filmed on location in The exhibit runs May 5 Orange County. through August 5, 2011.

As part of this historical exhibit, Bill Campbell will be accompanying the silent film, College, with Buster Keaton, on Saturday, June 4th, 2011 at 2:00 pm. The movie will be shown at the old Santa Ana Courthouse building, located at 211 W. Santa Ana Blvd in Santa Ana. Admission is free. Contact Bill Campbell for any further details.
